**ENACTED BY THE EKITI STATE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY as follows:**

*Amendment of Ekiti State Board of Internal Revenue Law, No. 13 of 2019.* 1. The provisions of the Ekiti State Board of Internal Revenue Law, No. 13 of 2019 (in this Law referred to as “the Principal Law”) is hereby amended as set out in this Law.

*Amendment of Section 3 (1) of the Principal Law* **Tenure of office of members of the Board.** 2. Section 3 (1) of the Principal Law is hereby amended by substituting Section 3 (1) with a new Section 3 (1) to now read as follows:  
**Section 3 (1): A member of the Board shall hold office at the pleasure of the Governor and as stated in his letter of appointment.**

3. This Law may be cited as Ekiti State Board of Internal Revenue (Second Amendment) Law, 2020.
